## **AUGUST-SEPTEMBER**

Visit the college campus(es) that you're interested in applying to, if you haven't done so already.

## SEPTEMBER-OCTOBER

- 1. Apply to the university of your choice. Make sure to check their website for deadlines.
  - Have questions? Reach out to the university admissions office. They are there to help you with all of your application needs.
- 2. Most universities have a specific transfer application. Contact the university or do a quick Google search to see if the university you're applying to has a special application for transfer students.
- 3. Most college applications require a fee. If you need a fee waiver, you can find information at CFNC.org
- 4. You will need to submit an official transcript to the university(ies) you're applying to. Official transcripts must be submitted from ALL of the colleges you've attended (if you've attended more than one). You can request a transcript be sent from WCC on the College's website, www.wilsoncc.edu, but you'll need to contact any other colleges you've attended for official transcripts from their institution.
  - · You will also need to send an official transcript once you complete your last semester at WCC.

## OCTOBER-DECEMBER

Prepare scholarship applications and apply for scholarships. You can find scholarships directly through the university's website or CFNC.org.

# **JANUARY**

Submit your FAFSA form for financial aid as soon as possible. Make sure you select the school(s) you've applied to.

After your final semester, send the university an updated official transcript with all of your completed courses.

Once you've been accepted to your university, it's important to complete all required documentation. Keep a check on your mailbox (both physically and virtually) for communication from the university.

# GRADUATION APPLICATION

Apply for graduation during registration for your final semester or by March 1st if you are eligible to graduate in the upcoming summer semester. Please see your advisor for a graduation timeline and more detailed information.
